

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ELECTRONICS AND BATTERY MANUFACTURERS AND IMPORTERS



Member States should allow producers that are not established on their territory, but that are established in another Member State, to appoint an authorised representative to be responsible for fulfilling the obligations of that producer under this Directive.

According to the Waste Management Law of the Republic of Lithuania, manufacturers and importers of electronics (EEE) and batteries are obliged to:

■ conclude a contract with a licensed organization regarding:

- financing and organization of waste management of products;
- public education and information on waste management issues;
- implementation of waste management tasks.

■ producers supplying EEE to Lithuania's market, shall register and report all relevant information reflecting that producer's activities in that Member State to National Register GPAIS (www.gpais.eu).

If you not fulfil these obligations **strictly prohibits** the supply and distribution of electronic products to the market of the Republic of Lithuania.
